The Australian GUILD English Communication assessments are designed for the young to provide a basis for assessment in speech at the very early stage of development.

This syllabus is designed for preschoolers. There are THREE levels, namely K1, K2, K3. In all levels, the developments of skills and confidence are the main aim and a wide variety of options are available to facilitate the requirements and to make the scope as open as possible. Teachers or parents are allowed into the examination room so children see a familiar face and this relieves some of the stress they may feel. The level of examination is based on the child's proficiency of the English language and not on their age.

- Accuracy of Pronunciation
- Facial Expression & Presentation
- Enunciation – Articulation & Expression
- Voice Intonation, Rhythmic and Dynamic
- Personality & Style with appropriate gesture and actions
